BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day, personally appeared <u>Sergeant Jason Lundquist</u>, known by me to be a credible person who after being duly sworn, upon oath deposes and says that has good reason to believe and does believe that, <u>LAURA SANCHEZ</u>, heretofore on or about the 28THth day of May, 2020, in the State of Texas and County of McLennan, did then and there intentionally or knowingly cause serious bodily injury or serious mental deficiency, impairment, or injury, to wit: death to a person, namely <u>FRANKIE GONZALES</u>, who was a child 14 years of age or younger to wit, 2-years-old.

Affiant bases his belief on the following facts:

Affiant is Sergeant Jason Lundquist. Affiant is an Investigator for the Waco Police Department. Affiant has been employed as a peace officer for the past 20 years. Affiant is currently assigned to the Crimes Against Children Unit. Affiant is responsible for investigating any crimes committed against children to include physical abuse. Affiant has completed significant specialized training associated with the investigations of crimes committed against children including children who are victims of physical injury.

On 6-1-2020 Laura Sanchez reported to the Waco Police Department that her son, Frankie Gonzales had gone missing from Cameron Park. After an exhaustive search Frankie was not found. The Affiant interviewed Sanchez who told the Affiant that Frankie had been with her adult son in Killeen, Tx over the weekend. Affiant was able to interview family members who said that was a lie. The Afffiant interviewed Sanchez that evening and determined she had told several lies.

On 6-2-2020 Sanchez's brother called the Affiant and said his sister had confessed. The Affiant immediately went to Sanchez. After being mirandized she told the Affiant that Frankie was dead in a dampster-somewhere around 27th/Park Lake. The Affiant drove Sanchez to the area where she guided the Affiant to a dumpster behind a church at 27th/Alice Ave. The Affiant found the body of Frankie Gonzales in several trash bags in the dumpster.

Sanchez told the Affiant that she had been the only person in care and custody of Frankie on approximately May 28th when he died. The Affiant knows that there is no way that Gonzales caused his own death. Sanchez told the Affiant she kept Frankie's body in her house until about May 30th when she disposed of it in the dumpster.
